- Dr. Brown: Sure, I'd like to share the part that tells how Nelly had the passion for promoting women's education since she was 11 years old, when she visited Ladakh with her father.
- Grace: So she knew the importance of education at that young age?
- Dr. Brown: That's right. You see, her father was a medical doctor who visited various parts in India to train young doctors. She respects her father very much. She wrote in her book that it was heartbreaking to see so many unfortunate women in India. They were not treated properly because they were not given the opportunity to go to school to learn how to read and write.
- Grace: I truly admire her. She is a kind and thoughtful person. I hear that there are many women who cannot read or write to this day.
- Dr. Brown: Indeed, Nelly is a strong person who was determined to make this project to educate women in Ladakh come true.
- Grace: Well, Dr. Brown, we'll take a short break. Please stay tuned for more stories about Nelly's book.
