Explanation of How to Wear Yukata

Hello. Today, I will explain how to wear a yukata, which is a traditional Japanese summer clothes often worn at festivals and casual events. First, put on the yukata like a robe, slipping your arms into the sleeves. Place your left-hand side over your right-hand side and secure it — never the other way around, as wrapping right over left is reserved only for those who passed away.
